Scholarship Details

\$1000 award. Normally directly deposited to student's school account

Payout expected June 2019

Deadline – April 30

Scholarship Eligibility

Scholarship is intended for students who have and will have a desire to apply their individual expertise to provide real-world environmental solutions

Students must have a connection to NW FL¹

Students of: NW FL colleges and universities: NWFSC, PSC, UF-Milton, UWF, etc.

Students who reside in NW FL but attending colleges and universities outside of NW FL

**Winner of a scholarship must attend an AWMA chapter meeting prior to receiving funds
(June 7, 2019 meeting is preferred)**

Student must be full time student

Recipient shall only be awarded the scholarship one time

Declared Major - Environmental Science, Engineering or any physical science

Scholarship Application

- GPA – Submit copy of most recent transcript
- Résumé – Provide a one-page résumé
- Essay – Describe your personal and professional environmental goals in 500 words or less.
- Letters of Recommendation – At least two but no more than three letters of recommendation must be submitted. Two ways to submit. 1) Direct email or 2) US Postal Service letters which should be in sealed envelopes with the recommender's signature across the back flap.
