2. Is the abstract clear, concise and organized?
3. Does the subject matter represent sound science and/or engineering, or if applicable, legal analysis?

**Scientific Content and Graphics of Poster Display (50 Points) \_\_\_\_\_/50**

1. Does the poster include the title, an author listing and the affiliations of all authors?
2. Are the figures, tables, and text clearly readable, properly labeled and appropriate to the subject matter?
3. Is the material in the poster technically / legally correct and intellectually sound?
4. Is the development and layout of the presentation complete, organized and logical?

**Oral Communication (40 points) \_\_\_\_\_/40**

1. Is the student able to effectively articulate the major ideas and conclusions of the work presented in the poster in the given timeline?
2. Does the student demonstrate a depth of understanding of the work's significance?
3. Can the student answer relevant questions that go beyond the material presented?
