Scholarship Eligibility

- Scholarship is intended for students who have and will have a desire to apply their individual expertise to provide real-world <u>environmental</u> solutions
- Students must have a connection to the Florida Panhandle¹
 - Students of Florida Panhandle colleges and universities: NWFSC, PSC, UF-Milton, UWF, FSU, FAMU, TCC, etc.
 - Students who reside in Florida Panhandle but attending colleges and universities outside of Panhandle
- Winner of a scholarship must attend an AWMA chapter meeting (can be virtual if appropriate) prior to receiving funds
- Full Time Student will be priority, but parttime accepted
- Recipient shall only be awarded the scholarship one time
- Eligible Majors Environmental, Sciences (including Science Education), Engineering or any physical science or law
